Video Tech

Time Commitment: 2 Hours/week. Once a month.

You will be:

- Using ProPresenter and Keynote to run words for worship, sermon notes, and videos
- Playing pre and post service music from iTunes
- Working hand in hand with Sound Tech for a service's video and audio cues
- Recording the message for the morning

Additional Information:

Training will be provided. Training is typically covered over two Sundays: One where you sit next to someone and watch them and another where they sit next to you and watch you. Arrival time is 10am to go over the order of service (9am is recommended if you're unfamiliar with most of our worship songs)

Kid's Check-In

- Tearing down the Check-In stations when everyone is checked out
